Newman YMCA Transportation Policy

Dear Parent or Guardian- Please go over the following bus/van rules with your child and Explain the importance of each in relation to vehicle safety. Thank you!

Bus\Van Rules Agreement for

1. Children must be seated and buckled in at all times.
2. Bus and Van drivers are to be strictly obeyed.
3. No food or drink is to be consumed on the vehicle.
4. Children are to face forward while vehicle is in motion.
5. Children are to keep their hands in the vehicle at all times.
6. Children are not to throw anything inside or out of the vehicle.
7. Children are expected to speak in a normal tone, no yelling or shouting.
8. If the child(ren) do not follow these rules they may lose transportation privileges.
9. Parents are required to call us at 508-336-7103 if your child(ren) will not be on our vehicle, so that we may inform our drivers. Failure to do so may result in a \$10.00 charge.

Please note that if these rules are not followed, the actions below will be taken:

- ① 1st Incident - Verbal Warning
- ② 2nd Incident – Written Warning
- ③ 3rd Incident – Participant will be expelled from riding our vehicle to and from the Y. The child will still be allowed to attend the program, but they will not be allowed to use our transportation.
